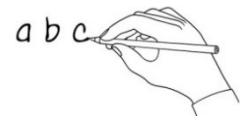

4. Play a game!

- Take turns to roll a dice. Look at the number and colour a part of your skeleton!
 - 1 = Colour the body OR the head.
 - 2 = Colour the mouth OR the neck.
 - 3 = Colour a shoulder OR a knee.
 - 4 = Colour an arm OR a leg.
 - 5 = Colour a hand OR a foot.
 - 6 = Colour the fingers OR the toes.
- If you have already coloured all the body parts for that number, you miss a turn!
- The first person to finish colouring their skeleton is the winner!
